## **Travel Team Descriptions, Fees, Travel Costs**

### **House/Rec Development**

The House/Rec provides an opportunity for new players and experienced players and their families who are not interested in the higher costs and time requirements of Travel hockey. This division is primarily for the younger age groups (6U, 8U, 10U, 12U and 14U). House/Rec teams can add players after the start of the season. The USA Hockey American Development Model (ADM) is heavily emphasized with House/Rec players including practice to game ratios and skills. House/Rec teams are not eligible for out of state play. The House/Rec season may be shorter allowing players to participate in other sports. Out of state players are not allowed. Players may participate on other youth travel teams but not Tier teams. House/Rec players play cross or half-ice games. <https://www.admkids.com/>

### **Travel B**

Travel B teams are designed for players and parents that are interested in playing at a high level of play but who lack the experience. Players and Parents at Travel B and are looking for an emphasis on developmental hockey. This division participates in the Utah in-state league, Utah Travel Hockey League (UTHL). Travel B teams play against the other Travel B teams in Utah. Travel B players are not eligible to play on other youth travel and tier teams. Out of state players are not allowed on Travel B teams. Travel B teams may travel out of state a maximum of 3 times, during the season to participate in Travel B tournaments. Travel B teams may participate in unlimited in-state tournaments.

### **Travel A Teams**

Travel A teams may participate in the in-state league, Utah Travel Hockey League (UTHL) as well as 3 or more out of state "A" or "AA" level tournaments per season. Travel A teams are designed for players and parents who are ready for a greater level of time and financial commitment. Travel A level is for experienced players that seek to compete at the highest level possible within their age division. Travel A 10U and 12U teams may participate in any tournament of similar skill. Travel A players may not play on other youth travel and tier hockey teams (no double rostering). Out of state players are not allowed. Billed players are not allowed.

### **Tier II Teams**

Tier II teams must play a Tier II USA Hockey sanctioned tournament schedule. Tier II teams travel out of state monthly and sometimes more than once a month. Teams may not participate in Tier I (AAA) tournaments. Utah Tier II teams may play against Tier I (AAA) teams only if the certain conditions are met according to the Utah Amateur Hockey Association policies. Tier II teams travel out of state for most games. Tier II teams are nationally bound teams meaning that they will compete for the Tier II title in their age division with the winner representing Utah in the USA Hockey National Championships tournament, in their age division. Competition is high, the time and financial demand is significant for the Tier II player and family.

### **Fees**

Fees will vary by each team. Fees are disclosed in the Team Facts Sheets that will be posted on the Ogden Jr Mustangs website on Tryout Day. The cost of game uniforms is in addition to the team fees. The parent/guardian is responsible for the cost of the player's protective equipment.

### **Travel Costs**

All player travel costs are the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Travel costs include transportation, lodging, and meals. The program does not cover these costs.
